<p>Bible Story: Review all Bible stories!</p> <p>Bible Memory: Review all Bible verses!</p>	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Prayer •Bible Story: Review the stories using the picture sheets placed in the Joyful Heart Rhyme Time binder. •Bible Memory Review all the verses using the Joyful Heart Memory Verse sheets in the binder. •Songs and Movement: Review songs used throughout the year! •Nursery Rhyme: Review nursery rhymes used throughout the year! •Phonemic Awareness: Alliteration -Oddity Task -- Show three or four pictures. Ask the child to tell you which picture does not begin with the same sound as the other pictures. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Story: <u>The Very Hungry Caterpillar</u> by Eric Carle Talk about the changes seen in the caterpillar as the story progresses as well as the beautiful transformation of the caterpillar turning into a butterfly. Compare this to a new life in Christ. (2 Corinthians 5:17) •Theme Related Activities: 1) Sing ‘The Butterfly’ 2) Make a contact paper butterfly. Draw a large butterfly shape on the clear plastic side of contact paper. Peel from the backing and place on the table sticky side up, taping the corners down. Have your child place brightly colored tissue paper squares inside the butterfly outline. Attach a second sheet of contact paper on top of the butterfly. Cut on the lines. Wrap the middle section with a pipe cleaner. 3) Put together a ‘Very Hairy’ caterpillar and watch it grow over the next week! 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Sing/Chant/Move to ABC’s •Review Game or Flashcards for colors, shapes, numerals, name, birthday, phone number, address, and letters studied • Calendar/Oral Counting with Movement (Same daily.) • Review Sort pictures of fruits, similar to those in <u>The Very Hungry Caterpillar</u>. Create AB patterns! 	
	2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Prayer •Bible Story: Review the stories using the picture sheets placed in the Joyful Heart Rhyme Time binder. •Bible Memory Review all the verses using the Joyful Heart Memory Verse sheets in the binder. •Songs and Movement: Review songs used throughout the year! •Nursery Rhyme: Review nursery rhymes used throughout the year! 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Story: <u>From Caterpillar to Butterfly</u> by Deborah Heiligman •Theme Related Activities: 1) Sing ‘The Fuzzy Caterpillar’. 2) Fold a paper butterfly cut out in half. Open it up and paint one side only. Refold and reopen the butterfly. You should see both sides painted - symmetrically! 3) Sequence the life cycle of a butterfly! First make an edible cycle using a pretzel and Corn Pops cereal. Then, place the pictures in order on the middle section of the symmetrical butterfly. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sing/Chant/Move to ABC’s • Review Game or Flashcards for colors, shapes, numerals, name, birthday, phone number, address, and letters studied • Calendar/Oral Counting with Movement (Same daily.) • Review Make butterflies with numerals, shapes, colors, etc. on the back side of the middle section. Fold each butterfly in thirds so that the writing appears on the top when it is placed on the ground. Insert a numeral, etc. into the ‘Tiny Caterpillars’ song and, after singing the song, have your child find the corresponding caterpillar, open it up, and fly it up and around. 	

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Phonemic Awareness: Syllable Splitting and Segmenting -Say a word from any of the past nursery rhymes. Have your child say the word slowly, using a 'syllable shaker' to shake the number of syllables in each word.

Dog!") 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Story: <u>Waiting for Wings</u> by Lois Ehlert • Theme Related Activities 1) Make and eat Pretzel Winged Butterflies! 2) Create a Coffee Filter Butterfly. Using colored markers, color all over one side of a coffee filter. Fold it up into a small pie piece. Dip the tip of the filter in water. Watch the colors go up and mix together. Open it up and let dry. Once dry, fold it in half and slide a large, round clothespin in the middle. Use pipe cleaner for the antennae. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sing/Chant/Move to ABC's • Review Game or Flashcards for colors, shapes, numerals, name, birthday, phone number, address, and letters studied • Calendar/Oral Counting with Movement (Same daily.) • Review Review all letters Aa-Zz! Cut butterfly patterns in half to form a puzzle. Write an uppercase letter on one side and the corresponding lowercase letter on the other. Have your child match the uppercase and lowercase letter halves. Review and sing the corresponding Letter Song for each letter as a match is made.
