### Phonemic Awareness

- \*Rhyming
  - Pause and let fill in/say missing rhyming word
  - Rhyme Box - match items that rhyme
- \*Alliteration
  - Oddity Task -- Show three or four pictures. Ask the child to tell you which picture does not begin with the same sound as the other pictures.
- \*Syllable Splitting and Counting
  - Place one penny in a jar as you say each syllable in the nursery rhyme.
  - Show and say the name of each real coin. Have your child lay a shoe cutout down for each syllable. Count the number of syllables for each coin's name!
