Phonemic Awareness

- *Rhyming
-Pause and let fill in/say missing rhyming word
- *Alliteration
-Find groups of 4 pictures that begin with the same sound. Place one of each on a stem, two leaves, and on a bud. Mix them up. Have your child match the stems and leaves to the buds to make an alliteration flower garden!
- *Syllable Splitting and Counting
-Place one seed in a pot as you say each syllable in the nursery rhyme.
- *Blending Onsets and Rimes
-Show three pictures (of compound words). Have a puppet slowly say one of the names of the pictures. Have your child point to and say the name of the picture that the puppet is wanting. (exp. flowerpot, butterfly, ladybug, etc)
