Phonemic Awareness

*Rhyming

-Pause and let fill in/say missing rhyming word
-Draw a simple chalk picture of a vehicle. Make up
rhymes to erase away the parts of the vehicle until it
is gone! (exp. 'You won't be able to drive at nights if
you erase the ____'.)

*Alliteration

-Alliteration Ride -- "I'm going on a ride and I will take
____." (Place a picture or small object in the back of a toy
truck. Lay other pictures spread out. Let the child choose
and say items that begin with the same sound as the item in
the back of the truck. For greater challenge, brainstorm
other things that begin with the same sound.)

*Blending Onsets and Rimes

-Say a word from the nursery rhyme or from the
Bible Story, broken into its' onset and rime (exp.
for - give, /p/ - ig, etc.) Have the child say
the word blended together.
