### Phonemic Awareness

- \*Auditory Discrimination
  - When hearing two 'baby' sounds, telling if they are the same or different (exp. crying, giggling, shaking a rattle, dada, etc.)
  - Listen for words and phrases that are the same and different (exp. Great job!, Bless you. I feel sad.)
- \*Rhyming
  - Pause and let fill in/say missing rhyming word
- \*Segmenting Sentences
  - Jump one time as each word in the nursery rhyme is spoken
