Phonemic Awareness

- *Auditory Discrimination
 - Listening Meal Prep.-- listen for sounds in the kitchen as someone makes a meal and tell the cook what is happening without you looking!
 - Move a certain way when a word is repeated in the nursery rhyme
- *Rhyming
 - Pause and let fill in/say missing rhyming word
 - Draw a simple chalk picture of a child. Make up rhymes to erase away his body parts until he is gone! (exp. 'He won't be able to see the pie if you erase his ____'.)
- *Segmenting Sentences
 - Pretend to take a bite of soup as each word in the nursery rhyme is spoken
